## Interesting Facts

- The Courthouse is named for A. Grenville Davis - a former Brampton Crown Attorney, and his son, the Honourable William Davis - former Premier of Ontario and opened in 2000.
- JOT (Justice on Target) is a province-wide effort to reduce delay in Ontario's criminal courts.
- In 2011, 25,700 prisoners were held in custody in the Brampton Courthouse.
- The maximum capacity of the Brampton Court cells is 300 prisoners at any one time.
- 168 cameras monitor activities in the cells
- 233 handcuffs are designated for use at the courthouse
- Five elevators are used to service the transport of prisoners to courtrooms.
- Superior Court Justices are appointed by the federal government and Ontario Court Justices are appointed by the provincial government.
- The Ministry of the Attorney provides Interpreters for 104 different languages.
- New time capsule was created September 16, 2010 for the 10-year anniversary of the courthouse and is mounted on the wall beside the Information Desk.
- Courtney and her family of Peregrine Falcons called the Brampton Courthouse home in 2011 as did a family of Canada Geese in the spring of 2012.
