

Ian Pettigrew Receives 2015 Hux-Kiteley Exemplary Justice Educator Award

The 2015 Hux-Kiteley Award was presented to Ian Pettigrew in front of an audience of teachers at the Ontario Teachers Federation Curriculum Forum on November 7th.
